History

The WATCH D.O.G.S. (Dads of Great Students) program is a national program that was started in 1998. This program is one of the nation's largest school-based, family, and community engagement, organizations in the country. The program was developed for fathers and father-figures to help make a positive impact on millions of children by volunteering in their local school. Those who take part in this organization volunteer to serve at their children's school in a variety of school activities as assigned by the school principal/leadership group.

The Goals of WATCH DOGS are: 1.) Provide positive male role models for students. Watch D.O.G.S. demonstrate through their presence and actions that education is important
2.) Provide extra sets of eyes and ears to enhance school security and reduce bullying.

Q: What are the steps to be a part of this program?

A: You must receive a Watch D.O.G.S handbook, get your background check completed,

purchase a WATCH DOGS T-shirt (http://dadsofgreatstudents.com/about-dogs-store),

Q: What do WATCH DOGS do (while they are at school)?

A: During the day WATCH DOGS may read, work on flash cards, or practice basic skills

with students, eat lunch with students, patrol the school entrances and hallways, assist

with traffic flow and any other assigned activities where they actively engage with not

only their own students, but with other students as well.



Daily Orientation

Step 1: Thank you for volunteering!

Step2: Orientation

- Be Approachable- smile, talk to the children, listen to them
- Be Alert- if a situation arises, please report it to Mrs. Carter
- Be Available- the goal is to be of service to the school, teachers, and students.
- Be a Positive Role Model.

Step 3: General Guidelines

- Never use the student (boys' or girls') restrooms. (Restrooms are located in the Teacher's lounge)
- Never be alone with a student—always be visible to others
- Do not be disruptive when you enter a class or in the hallways.
- Do not use profanity
- Do not use tobacco on the school grounds
- Do not share religious or political views
- Do not sell or give your official WATCH D.O.G.S T-shirt or vest to someone who isn't an approved Watch DOG volunteer
- Do not take pictures of students
- Do not post pics on social media
