Policy on the use of E-readers at Grace Miller Elementary School

*E-reader is a Kindle, Nook or other device designed for the purpose of reading e-books

In recognizing that e-readers are growing in popularity and are increasingly being used to support literacy instruction and personal reading, an exception to our electronic device policy will be made for bringing e-readers, **for the sole purpose of reading**, to school under the following conditions:

1. An understanding that the student
 - a. Will comply with the BUSD Acceptable Use Policy and will not use the e-reader for any purpose other than for reading age-appropriate content already downloaded on the device.
 - b. Student/Parent will put the name of the student on the device in a permanent way (marker, etching, etc.)
 - c. Will assume responsibility for the e-reader while on school property and will not loan the e-reader to another student in school or during school bus travel whether to/from school or on fieldtrips, or leave the e-reader unsupervised (on desk, in hall, on school bus, etc.) at any time.
 - d. The school is not financially responsible for the loss or damage to the e-reader while on school property or at a school related event.
 - e. Will not access any wireless network for use with the e-reader. Books must be downloaded onto the e-reader away from the school campus.
 - i. Internet access may be granted by the classroom teacher on a "as directed" basis.
 - ii. Internet access will be used for classroom research and investigation only.
 - f. The e-reader may not be used at recess (morning or lunchtime).
 - g. May be asked to show the e-reader and its contents to school personnel at any time.
